

Arthur A. Kopp, assistant director of student services at District One Technical Institute-Eau Claire, died Saturday in Luther Hospital.

Mr. Kopp, 59, of 2808 Starr Ave., was born in the Town of Brunswick and was a lifetime resident of the area.

He received a bachelor's degree in history from the University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire and a masters degree in guidance from UW-Stout.

He had been principal of Augusta High School and served as superintendent of schools. He taught school at Black River Falls and Hayward prior to coming to Eau Claire to teach social studies and English at the Vocational School in September, 1960.

He was a veteran of World War II and past-president of the Toastmasters and Lions Clubs. In September, 1965, he became a guidance counselor and was named assistant director for student services in September, 1968.

The school will be closed Wednesday at 12:35 p.m. to allow faculty and students to attend the funeral.

Survivors include his wife, Ruth; three sons, Ron, Mark and Wayne, all of Eau Claire; one sister, Miss Irene Kopp, and one brother, Richard, both of Eau Claire.

Services will be at 1:30 p.m. Wednesday in Hope Lutheran church with burial in Brunswick Cemetery.
