Cecil Wayne Beede, 75, 504 W. Tyler Ave., died Wednesday (September 4, 1985) at Sacred Heart Hospital, Eau Claire.



He was born in the town of Houghtonberg, Jackson County, on March 12, 1910, and married Muriel Haugen June 16, 1939, in Neillsville. He served in the U.S. Navy during World War II.

He graduated from Whitewater State Teachers College and received a master's degree from the University of Iowa.

He taught at Melrose and Owen High Schools before moving to Eau Claire in 1942, where he was an instructor and supervisor of business courses at the Vocational School.

He was appointed Director of the school in 1963. When the vocational schools were organized through districts in 1967, he was appointed District Director, retiring in 1974.

Survivors include his wife; a daughter, Kay Brummeyer, Menomonie; a son, Gary, Hartland; a sister, Elgie Beede, Hatfield; and five grandchildren.

Services will be held at 11:30 a.m. n Saturday at Grace Lutheran Church with burial in the Neillsville City Cemetery.
