Rosanne Marie Heidenreich, age 76, of Oshkosh, was called by God to join Him in His eternal home on Saturday, February 25, 2012. Her parents, Frank and Mildred (Stekel) Heidenreich welcomed her as their first child on May 8, 1935, on the family farm in Vernon County, near Yuba, Wisconsin.

As a young child, Rosanne attended Jewel School and Hillsboro High School. She continued her schooling at St. Francis Hospital School of Radiologic Technology in LaCrosse, University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire, University of Wisconsin-Stout, and the [University of Minnesota](#)-Minneapolis, Brigham Young University in Provo, Utah. She was a Registered Radiologic Technologist, Radiography (RT) at St. Agnes Hospital in Fond du Lac, Radiology Department Supervisor/Manager at St./ Francis Hospital, LaCrosse, Associated Physicians Clinic in Madison, and Dean Clinic in Madison.

For many years, Rosanne, was a Radiograph Instructor at Chippewa Valley Technical College in Eau Claire.
