Patrick "Pat" T. Schuh died with family at his side after a brief battle with lung cancer on August 10th, 2024, at 5:40 am at Mayo Clinic Health System Red Cedar in Menomonie, Wisconsin. It was a beautiful sunny morning when he met God face to face.
